

True Bible Teaching About... "Angels"

THEY ARE CREATED BEINGS:

Psa.148:2, 5: "Praise ye him, all his angels...for He commanded and they

were created."

THEY PERFORM GOD'S WILL:

Psa.103:20, : "Bless the LORD, ye his angels, that excel in strength, that

21 do his commandments, hearkening unto the voice of his

word."

THEY STAND IN GOD'S PRESENCE:

Matt.18:10 : "...their angels do always behold the face of my Father

which is in heaven."

Luke 1:19 : "I am Gabriel, that stand in the presence of God."

THEY WERE PRESENT AT OUR CREATION:

Job 38:4-7 : "Where wast thou when I laid the foundations of the earth?

When the morning stars sang together and all the sons of

God shouted for joy."

Psa. 33:6-9 : "By the word of the LORD were the heavens made; for He

spake and it was done; He commanded and it stood

fast."

Gen. 1 : "God" = "Elohim (Heb.) = Mighty Ones."

THEY ARE IMMORTAL, SPIRIT BEINGS:

Lk. 20:36 : "Neither can they (the faithful) die any more; for they are

equal unto the angels."

THEY LOOK AFTER GOD'S PEOPLE:



Psa. 34:7 : "The angel of the LORD encampeth round about them that

fear him, and delivereth them."

Heb. 1:14 : "Are they (angels) not all ministering spirits, sent forth to

minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation?"

THEY APPEAR AS MEN:

Gen. 18:2 : "And Abraham lifted up his eyes and looked, and lo, three

men stood by him."

Jud. 13:10-: "...for Manoah knew not that he was an angel of the LORD."

THEIR DIVINE GLORY CAN BE HIDDEN OR ALLOWED TO SHINE FORTH:

Matt. 28:3 : "His countenance was like lightning, and his raiment white

as snow."

THEY ARE LIMITED IN POWER AND KNOWLEDGE:

Gen. 19:22 : "...I cannot do anything till thou be come thither."

Dan. 10:13 : "Michael, one of the chief princes came to help me."

Mark 13:32 : "But of that day or that hour no one knows, not even the

angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father."

THE FAITHFUL ARE PROMISED EQUALITY WITH THEM:

Lk. 20:35,36: "But they which shall be accounted worthy to obtain that

world, and the resurrection from the dead, neither marry nor are given in marriage; neither can they die any more;

for they are equal unto the angels."

THE WORLD TO COME (KINGDOM OF GOD) WILL NOT BE LOOKED AFTER BY THE PRESENT ANGELS:

Heb. 2:5 : "For unto the angels hath he not put in subjection the world

to come, whereof we speak."

The word "angel" is from Hebrew and Greek words meaning "messenger".

When the context showed that a mortal man was meant, the translators used the word "messenger' instead of "angel".

For Example:



1Kings 19:2: "Then Jezebel sent a messenger unto Elijah, saying..." "And Elisha sent a messenger unto Naaman" 2Kings 5:10: "And when the messengers of John were departed..." Lk. 7:24 The "angels that sinned" of 2 Peter 2:4 and Jude 6 must also be mortal men, as immortal angels do not sin. "Evil angels" of Psa. 78:49 are called "destroying angels" in other versions.
